THIRTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
 OCTOBER - THE MONTH OF OUR LADY OF THE HOLY ROSARY -
 MASS and ROSARY DEVOTIONS (SUNDAY through Thursday) - In observance of October's dedication to the Most Holy Rosary, we will be celebrating daily evening Holy Mass (Monday through Thursday this final week) at 7 PM in Polish followed by DEVOTION to The MOST HOLY ROSARY.

BEATIFICATION OF CARDINAL WYSZYŃSKI SOON. Primate of Poland, Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński will be beatified on June 7, 2020 at Pilsudski Square in Warsaw. The ceremony will be conducted by a Vatican envoy, the Prefect of the Congregation for the Causes of Saints, His Eminence Cardinal Giovanni Angelo Becciu. Pope Francis has recognized a miracle attributed to the late Polish Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński, a revered icon of his country's resistance to communism in the post-war period, a step that moves him closer to sainthood. A Vatican statement from early October said the pope had approved a decree recognizing a miracle attributed to Wyszyński, who died in 1981 and was very close to Pope John Paul II. He spent three years in prison or under house arrest in the early 1950s during repression of religion by the communists. The miraculous healing through the intercession of the Primate concerns a young woman, a resident of Szczecin, who suffered from thyroid cancer 24 years ago. After an operation it turned out that there was metastasis. Doctors did not give her a chance to live. Then her despairing family started praying for her health, through the intercession of cardinal Wyszyński, unexpectedly, the woman recovered. The tumor disappeared, although from the medical point of view, the improvement of her health did not seem possible. Approval of the miracle means Wyszyński will be beatified. The Catholic Church teaches that only God performs miracles but that saints who are believed to be with God in heaven intercede on behalf of people who pray to them. A miracle is usually the medically inexplicable healing of a person.

TODAY (10/20) - SECOND COLLECTION - CHURCH REPAIR & MAINTENANCE FUND - We are so extremely thankful for the amazing and generous support all of our very kind parishioners and friends have shown our beloved Parish by thoughtfully supporting our monthly Church Repair & Maintenance Fund. While all seems fantastic, we must, however, report that there are serious repairs required to our Church/School's heating system - Boiler and Pipe repairs (in 10 places) requiring approximately \$10,000.00 in supplies only. We again, therefore, fervently and prayerfully request your continued generous financial assistance toward our Church Repair and Maintenance Fund so that we may bring these vital plumbing and heating repairs to fruition. Thank you most profoundly for your incredible support.

THURSDAY (10/31) - VIGIL MASS - will be celebrated for Solemnity of All Saints Day - at 7 PM in English. Celebration of this evening's Vigil Mass will suffice for the Holyday of Obligation. The October Rosary Devotion will follow this evening's Vigil Mass

FIRST FRIDAY (11/1) - ALL SAINTS' DAY - (Holyday of Obligation - "Let us rejoice in all the men and women blest in the eyes of the Lord; who celebrate the Heavenly Liturgy. They stand in God's holy place and sing of the love the Father has bestowed upon them through the blood of the Lamb." Our schedule of Masses in observance of today's special Solemnity of All Saints' Day will be celebrated at: 8:00 AM (English); and at 7 PM (Polish).

NOVEMBER PRAYER FOR THE DEAD
 A Novena of Holy Mass will be celebrated for the dead for 9 days from Nov. 1st - 8th at 7 PM, and we will pray for them in Wypominki. Please write the names of the deceased on special cards (in the denominator, legibly) and return to the sacristy and rectory.

FIRST SATURDAY (11/02) - THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED (ALL SOULS' DAY) - "The souls of the just are in God's hands. Christ, the Good Shepherd, died for us while we were still sinners. He is the resurrection and the life." On this extremely spiritually commemorative day, we traditionally try to remember all of our beloved deceased in prayers - we pray that their time spent in Purgatory, being cleansed of their sins, may be shortened and that they will soon rejoice in the glory of Our Savior's presence in Heaven. Beginning November 2nd all of our All Souls' Envelopes will be placed on our main Altar where throughout the month of November, the names of all of our dearly departed will be remembered during the Offertory of each of our November Masses. Additional All Souls' Day Envelopes are available in the vestibule of our Church. In observance of ALL SOULS' DAY, we will celebrate Holy Mass at 8 AM and 5 PM in English.

Abp Stanisław Gądecki, przewodniczący Konferencji Episkopatu Polski, poprosił papieża Franciszka o ustanowienie św. Jana Pawła II doktorem Kościoła i patronem Europy. Dziś, podczas kongresu „Europa Christi”, inicjatywę wsparł kard. Stanisław Dziwisz.

ZNAMY JUŻ DATĘ BEATYFIKACJI KARDYNAŁA WYSZYŃSKIEGO. Prymas Tysiąclecia Kard. Wyszyński zostanie beatyfikowany 7 czerwca 2020 r. w Warszawie, na placu Józefa Piłsudskiego. Proces beatyfikacyjny kardynała Stefana Wyszyńskiego trwał 30 lat. Przełomem było zatwierdzenie w styczniu 2019 roku przez Lekarzy Kongregacji Spraw Kanonizacyjnych cudu uzdrowienia za wstawiennictwem kardynała Stefana Wyszyńskiego. Niewytłumaczalne z medycznego punktu widzenia uzdrowienie dotyczy 19-letniej kobiety ze Szczecina, która zachorowała na nowotwór tarczycy z przerzutami. Lekarze nie dawali pacjentce szans na przeżycie. Podczas choroby grupa siostr zakonnych oraz jej bliskich modliła się za wstawiennictwem Ks. Prymasa Stefana Wyszyńskiego o zdrowie dla chorej. Zupełnie nieoczekiwanie nastąpiło trwałe uzdrowienie! Zatwierdzenie cudu przez konsylium lekarzy Kongregacji Spraw Kanonizacyjnych to jeden z najistotniejszych elementów procesu beatyfikacyjnego Prymasa Tysiąclecia.

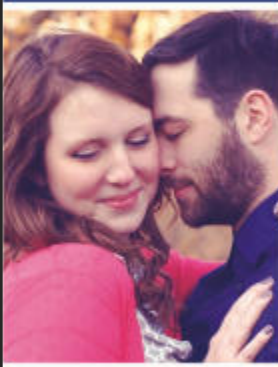
